GENERAL NEWS

THE SOCIETY FOR THE PROTECTION OF UNBORN

CHILDREN will be holding a Tiny Feet Coffee and Cake Sale, with a Celebration of Life Exhibition, in Our Lady of Victories Catholic Church, 1 Fairfield Road, Market Harborough, LE16 9QQ, on Saturday 4th July, from 10.00am until 4.00pm. All are very welcome.

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL is consulting on removing the discretionary transport for pupils and students attending Catholic Schools on a faith basis. The scheme currently supports nine of our schools, and if removed would have a serious impact:

1. Not being able to continue with Catholic education. It is the right of every parent to choose a faith education for their children.
2. Impact on emotional well-being of children who may be forced to move schools
3. Increased costs to many low-income families. Some may be forced to work less in order to ensure their children get to and from school
4. Additional safety issues for children if they have to access public transport – often requiring two buses and moving through town centres.
5. Removing these services would lengthen the school day for many children meaning travelling in the dark at both ends of the day in winter, which poses safety risks.
6. Longer journeys to and from school would impact negatively on children's physical and mental health.
